RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE USE OF A PORTION OF BEGINNING FUND BALANCE AS AUTHORIZED BY COLORADO STATUTES

WHEREAS, C.R.S. 22-44-105 states that a budget, duly adopted pursuant to this article, shall not provide for expenditures, interfund transfers, or reserves, in excess of available revenues and beginning fund balance.

WHEREAS, the Board of Education may authorize the use of a portion of the beginning fund balance in the budget, stating the amount to be used, the purpose for which the expenditure is needed, and the district's plan to ensure that the use of the beginning fund balance will not lead to an ongoing deficit.

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has determined the beginning fund balances in both the General Fund and the Capital Reserve Fund are sufficient to allow for the one-time expenditures and the action will not lead to an ongoing deficit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

In accordance with C.R.S. 22-44-105, the Board of Education authorizes the use of a portion of the FY2003-04 Beginning Fund Balance for the following funds: General Fund, in the amount of \$50,000 for the purpose of purchasing additional science resources according to the district's Curriculum Plan; Capital Reserve, in the amount of \$75,000 for a roofing project at Anywhere Elementary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the use of this portion of the beginning fund balance for the purpose/s set forth above will not lead to an ongoing deficit.
