

## Cooperative Educational Programming

Dolores School District Re-4A is a member of the Southwest Board of Cooperative Educational Services (BOCES).

The Board shall appoint one of its members to serve on the BOCES board and one member to serve as an alternate. Their terms of office shall have the same expiration date as the terms for which they are serving on the local Board.

The Board also shall appoint one of its members to serve on the San Juan Basin Technical College board of control for a three-year term of office.

It shall be their duty to keep the Board informed of BOCES and vocational school activities and programs.

The district shall participate in the programs offered by BOCES and the vocational school depending on the needs of the district.
