2019 CWOA SCHOLARSHIP ***ELIGIBILTY REQUIREMENTS**

1) Applicants must have a goal for education in the following:

Water Resources, Environmental Sciences, Engineering or Agricultural Studies

- 2) You must be a high school senior with a minimum GPA of 2.80. You must submit a certified transcript documenting your GPA.
- 3) You must enroll at a Colorado college or university during calendar year 2019. The scholarship committee will require proof of acceptance at the college or university prior to distribution of the scholarship funds. The funds will be sent directly to the scholarship fund at the college or university.
- 4) Applicant must reside in the San Juan/Animas/Dolores River Drainages (Water Division 7).
- 5) You must submit two (2) letters of recommendation from teachers, counselors or principal along with this application.
- 6) Answer the following questions on a <u>separate sheet of paper</u>.
 - a. Ten years after high school, in what career would you like to be working?
 - b. Please explain in your own words the following: "First in Time, First in Right" as it relates to Colorado Water Law (one or two paragraphs)
 - c. Choose a water-related project or current water-related event in your area and describe it (three paragraphs.)

Selection

Responses to the questions will be rated by a panel of water professionals that are <u>not</u> members of CWOA. This is a "blind" rating; members of the panel do not know the names of the applicants.

The scholarship selection committee will determine the eligibility of individual applicants.

The scholarship selection committee may choose to divide this award among two or more qualified individuals.
