NWEA TESTING BEGINS TODAY--MONDAY

We will begin with Reading. All students in grades 7-10, and those in success classes, will take the NWEA in Reading, Language Usage, Math, and Science. Please encourage your students to do their very best. We use this data to determine what our students know, and what they still need to learn. We will also use this data to make our final determinations about which students are truly in need of an ELA or Math success course, to provide support for skills development, alongside their regular English and Math courses.

ADVISORY THIS WEEK

- Students will begin their exploration of the 7 Mindsets, with an introduction and overview.
- Middle school students will spend a few days engaged in a short curriculum called "Start with Hello," where they will learn tools and tips for preventing social isolation. This curriculum is a total of 6 advisory class days over three weeks.
- 9-11 grade students will be completing "credit review" worksheets and plans, which will be coming home for you to review and sign. They will also begin the "Start with Hello" curriculum.

- Seniors will be introduced to their Google Classroom site, where they will find all documents and scholarships as they become available. They should be checking this site frequently. They will also meet with Superintendent Kasper.
- Students will also have an opportunity for grade checks and academic study time on Friday. See specifics about Seniors below.
- Over the course of the next few weeks, all students will also take the Multiple Intelligences Inventory. This is a "learning preferences" questionnaire which will help us better design assignments that work with student strengths, and also design assignments that develop their less desired learning preferences.
